Dear Parent/Carer,

We are very excited to announce that we have been successful in our application to work with Magic Breakfast to support our early morning breakfast provision. We are now able to offer breakfast to **all children absolutely free of charge!**

In order to do this we are altering our current early morning arrangements. We will be providing breakfast in two ways; firstly, we will offer a Traditional Breakfast Club for up to 100 children, this will consist of cereals and bagels. As before this will run from 8:30am and will be held in our Dining Hall. Please note we will not be offering an activity club separately. Children will access their classrooms from 8:45am where daily activities will be available. Traditional Breakfast Club will not be available for Nursery children.

Children not attending the Traditional Breakfast Club, can access 'Playground Bagels'. From 8:40am each morning staff will be on all yards including reception and nursery with toasted bagels for children to collect and eat while they are waiting for the doors to open. Children will be able to access classrooms from 8:45am where activities will be awaiting them.

Our new breakfast provision will start on Monday 10th September 2018, please note there will be no early morning provision for the first three days of the new term. To be able to plan effectively we need to know the number of children attending the Traditional Breakfast club, if this is your preferred option, please complete the attached form and return to school by Thursday 19th July 2018. You will receive a letter confirming your child's place. Remember, if you have not opted for this, your child will be able to collect a bagel on the yard before the start of the school day. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact myself or one of our PSAs, Mrs Mellis and Miss Burke.
