home by...

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Making relationships

- Let me build things using cardboard boxes, fabric or other household items.

Self-confidence and awareness

- Let me help you match up the socks.
- Let me show you how I can make something and ask for help when I need it.

Managing feelings and behaviour

- Let me play dress up and pretend to be someone else.
- Explain to me why I cannot do things like running around in a supermarket or cross the road without an adult.

Physical Development

Moving and handling

- Let me practice using scissors to cut paper.
- Make an obstacle course where I can [practice crawling through, climbing over, balancing on and running or walking around.
- Practice throwing and catching with me.

Health and self-care

- Make sure I brush my teeth twice daily.
- Encourage me to go to the toilet or potty.
- Help me learn to put on my own coat and try to zip it up.

Communication and Language

Listening and attention

- Play listening games with me
- Read me a story.

Speaking

- Talk to me about anything.
- Ask me questions.

Understanding

- Ask me questions about why we do things. Such as why we wear a hat and gloves, or why we don't touch the oven.
